An <u>Active Membership</u> is an eligible voting member of the ABC. You must attend two consecutive meetings from the date of application for membership to obtain voting rights. In order to maintain voting membership, an active member must attend 66% of meetings throughout the fiscal year.

A *Family Membership* must meet the same meeting attendance criteria as an Active Member, with attendance by at least one of the family members to be an eligible voting member.

An <u>Associate Membership</u> shall consist of volunteering to assist with ABC functions, no meeting attendance requirement or voting privileges.
